

## Tag up plays

\*All base runners should tag up on all foul balls

### At First base

- It takes good read to tag up from first. Relax and let your eyes give you the read
- If there is a runner on 2B who is tagging, the runner on 1B should also tag
- If the runner at 1B is the only runner, he should read the out elder If the out elder is camped, he should tag; if the out elder has his back to the runner, he should be halfway

### At Second base

- No outs vs One out
- Always position your body so you can see the ball
- General rules: with 0 outs, the objective is to get to 3rd base - With 1 out, the objective is to score
- A simple guideline is to tag with no outs and be halfway with one out
- Stay calm let the play develop
- There is a (hang-out area) and the distance varies based on the number of outs and the information the outfielder gives you let your eyes give you the read for action
